Christmas Performance - Baboushka - for parents of children in Mars Class, Sun Class and Star Class

The children in Mars Class, Sun Class and Star Class are all looking forward to performing 'Baboushka' for you later this week. Just a reminder that tickets are colour coded for each day:

Tuesday 8th December at 1.45pm → blue tickets

Wednesday 9th December at 9.45am → green tickets

Thursday 10th December at 6pm → red tickets

Do please remember to bring your tickets with you to the performance. A seating plan will be available to help you find your seats. Please do not come into school before 1.30pm for the afternoon performance and 9.30am for the morning performance as the hall will not be ready. If your circumstances have changed and you no longer need all your ticket allocation for any of the performances please could I ask that you return any unwanted tickets to the school office so that they may be redistributed to families who were unable to get seats for their preferred performance? Thank you.

For the evening performance on Thursday, please ensure your child is in school for 5.30pm. The performance lasts approximately one hour. If you are not attending the performance on Thursday evening please collect your child from their classroom at approximately 7pm. Please make sure you tell an adult you are leaving when you collect your child. Thank you.

For the evening performance only, there will be some parking available on the school site. Please drive through the car park to the playground. As there will not be a steward to help with parking, please can I urge you to drive with extreme caution. If you are parking in the village please ensure you park considerately. Thank you.

We have a few children already booked into our crèche for both Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday morning. Just to remind you that the crèche must be booked in advance for pre-school children and babies. There is still time to book a place if you are unable to make alternative arrangements for the duration of each daytime performance. Please let Mrs Stairs in the school office know if you require a place for your baby or toddler.
